As always if anyone needs any help please do not hesitate to get in contact with me.

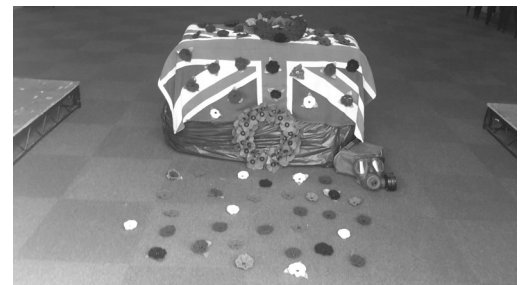

From The Rectory,



Dear Friends,

As I write I am half way through my self-isolation period and at times I have been climbing the Rectory walls whilst at other times enjoying going at a slightly slower pace and dare I say even catch up on my least favourite occupation, namely admin!

The two weeks have also given me the opportunity to get my head around how we are going to deliver Christmas across the Team, because as you might expect we cannot deliver in the 'normal way' this year due to restrictions placed upon us due to Covid 19.

I have resisted up until now making any of our services a ticketed affair and therefore with the PCCs approval here in Much Wenlock have taken the decision with a heavy heart not to hold a Christingle Service, Carol Service, Crib Service or Midnight Mass in Much Wenlock this year, as numbers would have to be significantly reduced and I personally wouldn't want to exclude or disappoint anyone if we had to turn people away.

Thankfully, we are actively working on an online alternative to all these special services that can be accessed via the website. We will however still hold 3 services on Christmas, Day at 8am, 9.30am & 11.30am, but these services will be ticketed and individuals as well as family groups will have to book a place via the website: www.muchwenlockchurch.co.uk A Holy Communion Service will also take place at Holy Trinity Bourton at 9.30am.

Please also take a walk into town in the early evening during the Christmas period as the Church Tower will be lit up with the Christmas story again this year to lift our spirits.

With this in mind the Church of England's Christmas initiative this year is entitled **Comfort and Joy** that holds together the hope that Christmas will bring joy and celebration after a uniquely difficult year with an acknowledgement that – for those who have lost loved ones or livelihoods, or who are potentially still not able to be together with loved ones – it may be the Church's role, both nationally and locally, to provide consolation, rather than assume everyone will be ready to join in jubilation. We also have to anticipate there may be further spikes.

This Christmas the Church will need, in the words of St Paul in Romans 12.15, to 'Rejoice with those who rejoice; weep with those who weep'. We will aim to celebrate where we can together in one place – but also embrace a wider community that wants to join in the celebration but may not be physically able – or emotionally ready – to do so.

The hope is that **Comfort and Joy** will enable us to build a campaign that both enables us to reconnect with the rich and joyous traditions of the past and to offer God's consoling love in the present. 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Dear All,

As I write this we are heading into our second 'Lockdown', and I hope that as you read this we are coming out into something that feels a little lighter, but as we have learned during this year, nothing is certain. This year has thrown many things at us which have been challenging at best, and we understand that you have had to adapt to so many changes in such a short time, which can feel exhausting. We appreciate that our Medical Practice has been one of those areas of your life which has had to change and adapt, and we are grateful to all of you for your patience and understanding throughout.

Flu Clinics

These have certainly been different this year thanks to COVID-19 and we have used differing ways to deliver safe and effective clinics including 'Drive Thru' clinics and 'Walk Thru' clinics at William Brookes School and smaller surgery based clinics. We are incredibly grateful to William Brookes School and their team who have been generous with their time and facilities, giving us support in running these clinics. We are also very thankful to our Patients' Voice group, with several members giving up their time to help run the clinics. We were asked by Public Health England to vaccinate specific risk groups initially, which we successfully did with our Drive Thru clinics. We then widened out our clinics to offer appointments to any of those aged over 65 years, or under 65 years with a pre-existing condition. To date we have vaccinated well over 1,000 patients and hope that all those who have attended have found the clinics safe and efficient. If anyone is reading this who is eligible and would like to have a vaccine please contact the surgery.

We know that earlier this year the government announced that they would aim to vaccinate those not normally eligible aged 50 – 64 years, however we have yet to be advised to start this process. We are awaiting notification from NHS England, and as soon as we have more information we will publicise any details.

We understand that it may have felt frustrating with the changes and how the vaccinations have been staggered in delivery. This year has been complicated by changes to those eligible to be vaccinated, the methods of vaccination, and the delivery of the vaccines themselves. We will learn from all of these experiences and improve how these are delivered in future.

And Finally....

We want you to know that things are difficult right now, but that we are still here for you. We have worked throughout this pandemic and will continue to do so until instructed otherwise. The way you access us may be different but we promise we are here to help, support and to continue giving you the best care we can.

Accessing GP Services

We are still providing general medical services to our patients as we always have but the way to access these has changed a little:

On line Consultations - eConsult

eConsult is an online platform that enables patients to request medical advice from their GP by simply undergoing an online consultation. During the online consultation patients may be provided with advice for self-help or information on other services to receive the care that aligns with their symptoms. If the GP feels that a patient needs a face-to-face appointment then they will contact the patient within 48 hours and invite them in for an appointment. For many medical queries the GP will contact the patient directly or instruct a member of the Practice team to contact the patient with GP advice. We may respond to your e-consultation via telephone, email or text message if you have given consent to receive text messages from the Practice. In order to ensure we meet the increasing demand and needs of our patients whilst ensuring our services are utilised appropriately, we encourage patients to utilise this service and to find further information visit the practice website:
www.muchwenlockandcressagemp.co.uk.

If you are unable to utilise the eConsult method of contacting the surgery and wish to seek advice from a GP you can book a telephone consultation with a doctor for a morning or afternoon call back. The GP will discuss your issue with you and if necessary arrange an appointment to see you face to face in the Practice. Please ensure you are available to receive a call at any time during the 4 hour window as we cannot give you a definite call back time. If you have an urgent on the day issue we are continuing to operate a duty doctor service and are also providing home visits where necessary for housebound patients or patients who are too ill to get to the Practice.

Nurse appointments and Health Care Assistant appointments

Appointments for essential treatments and tests are booked as previously by contacting the Practice by phone to book in. Please note that there is a reduction in the number of available appointments to allow for cleaning of areas in between appointments and to ensure social distancing between patients coming in to and leaving the Practice.

Chronic disease reviews are continuing though some of these are taking place via the telephone or video link rather than face to face. Patients are being invited for these appointments. Please bear with us if your review is overdue as we are catching up from the first lockdown period when all chronic disease reviews were suspended. If you are struggling to manage your chronic disease then please let us know. Please note we are currently unable to offer online bookable appointments.

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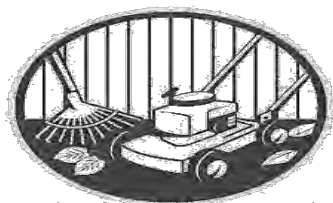
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News from Christ Church C.E. Primary School

Preparing, Sowing, Growing

Celebrating and enjoying being creative...

As we head towards Christmas at Christ Church, if you wandered along our corridor you would still hear children practising Christmas songs for a Nativity and other performances. We may not be able to invite parents and grandparents into school to watch because of Covid but we will still be celebrating in school. Each class will be filming their performances which will be shared with parents via our school remote learning platform, Seesaw.



At school, we appreciate the importance of creativity more than ever. As the world seems to grow a little smaller and darker with restrictions, it is important that children and adults can find joy and release in song, dance and art. Our Y6s have been having a fantastic time learning Samba drumming this term, and not only has this linked well with their 'Diversity' curriculum theme, it has been a great source of pride as they have worked as a team and managed to layer drumming rhythms together, that seemed impossible when they first started.



Our Y3s recently completed a lovely art project, using clay to make fruit tiles. Seeing how long it took – from the initial work with clay, through it drying out, being fired, then painted and fired again for glazing – was a really good lesson in perseverance and patience. These are qualities we are all needing 'in spades' as a country with the pandemic!

Physical exercise is also really important for mental well-being and the children had a great time raising money for new chairs across the school, in a PTA Sponsored Skip and Squat.

A huge thank you to the wider community who were very generous – the total raised was over £1,500.

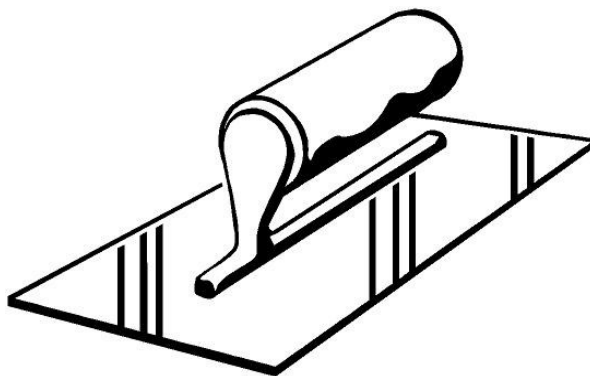
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
