CYBER SECURITY

Shropshire Council has been subjected to increased attempts from Cyber Hackers. This type of hacking is not only affecting major government institutions and organisations but can also affect us as individuals. The way this usually occurs is via “phishing” emails, the most sound advice is, if it’s from an address you don’t recognise or it doesn’t look right – don’t open it. Make sure you have good anti hack software on your laptop or PC and more advice can be found by visiting <https://www.ncsc.gov.uk/>

COUNCIL TAX REBATE

If you live in a Band A – D property and pay council tax to Shropshire Council you will be entitled to a £150 rebate. If you pay your bill to Shropshire Council by direct debit the £150 will be credited into your account in a separate payment. If you do not pay your bill by Direct Debit you may need to make a claim but I am waiting for final details on this. If you have any issues with this please email me.

COVID

Just a gentle reminder that Covid cases in the County are very high, in fact in the last week we have seen almost a 100% increase in cases and we are above the average for the West Midlands and England. Thankfully these high number of cases are not reflected in hospital admissions but please be cautious, keep your distance, wash your hands and wear a mask in enclosed spaces even though there is no legal requirement to do so. Please look after yourself and those around you.

UKRAINE

You will have seen the terrible footage from Ukraine in the news. Shropshire is ready and willing to help with welcoming refugees in the same way that we did for Syria and Afghanistan. It is a very worrying situation for all of us but our thoughts and prayers go out to all Ukrainians at this terrible time and we pray for a peaceful resolution to this humanitarian crisis. The Home Office has now announced a housing scheme and it is wonderful that, at time of writing, nearly 200,000 people have offered accommodation. This is alongside the incredible support both financial and via donations to many organisations, national and local, who have made trips to the Polish border to take out supplies. Community and Care Coordinator

We have a new Community and Care Coordinator – Jo Weaver-Jackson. Jo was previously a member of our reception team, but has now changed her role to help with coordinating care for our patients and is there to help guide patients and families through the systems which I think we can all agree, can often be complex and daunting. Jo can help with things like how to arrange care for your loved ones, local groups and events that you might find helpful, and essentially guiding through issues for our most vulnerable and in need patients.

She has hit the ground running and set up a great new weekly event for local people:

The Senior Lunch Club

This is going to run on a **WEEKLY** basis on a **TUESDAY** at **1 - 2pm** at **The Fox** pub in Much Wenlock (46 High Street, Much Wenlock, TF13 6AD). This will cost £5 per person which will include a 'light bite' to eat with a tea, coffee, or soft drink. Jo will be there on hand to answer any questions you may have about things, or just show you pictures of her lovely dogs! We will also try and get our Co-Co volunteers to attend some of the lunches so you can meet them and talk about the services they offer. The idea is that this will give local residents an opportunity to meet and socialise in a relaxed atmosphere, and the chance to seek any advice and guidance on care related matters in a more laid back environment. There is no strict age limit, as we want to welcome anyone who would like to come.

- Fish and Chips
- Omelette

It would be great to see a few of our patients there and enjoying the opportunity to get out and meet others, enjoying some food and maybe getting a little extra help from us at the same time.

Prescription Ordering Direct

We appreciate that it has now been a few months since we moved to Prescription Ordering Direct (POD), and hopefully you are now finding this a convenient way to request repeat prescriptions with access all day during the week, in addition to email access. We receive feedback from the POD concerning the call waiting times as we were aware this was a point of concern for some of our patients. I hope the following statistics offers some reassurance in terms of the time calls are answered. It may sound like there are many people in the queue, but remember, there are many call handlers working so the queue moves very quickly.

During the month of February the percentage of calls answered in different time frames were as follows
Answered in...

- Less than 5 minutes : 95.1%
- Less than 10 minutes : 99.69%
- Less than 15 minutes : 99.97%
- More than 15 minutes : 0.01%

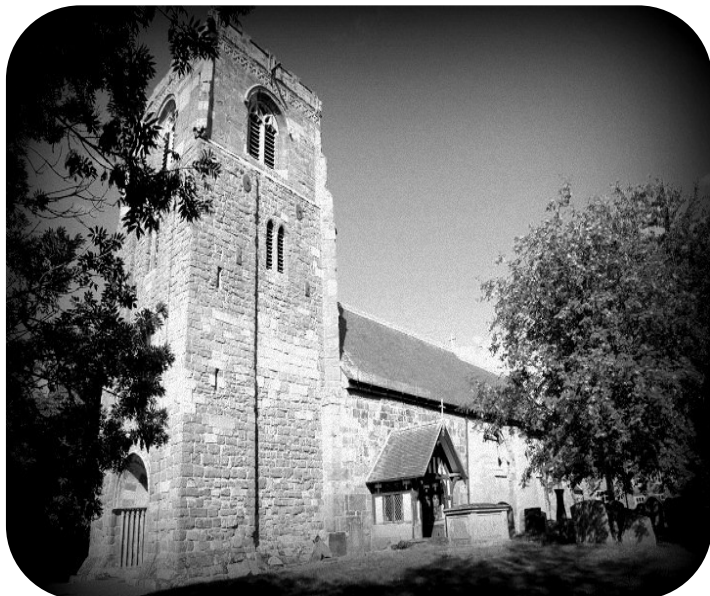

Before you report a missed collection **please wait until 5pm** (because the collection crews may still be out working). Also check:

- that your containers were out on the right day.
- that your containers were out by **7am**
- that your containers were out in the correct place
- that your lid was closed and no extra waste was next to your bin
- that the correct waste was in the containers

Shropshire Council will investigate the incident and if your collection has genuinely been missed they will come back and collect it within two working days.

Local Health Champions want to hear about NHS psychological services

Depression and anxiety levels in Shropshire, Telford & Wrekin have increased since the start of the pandemic. The Shropshire Primary Care Psychological Therapies Service (also known as IAPT) and Telford IAPT are at the forefront of support and therapy to help people to deal with mild and moderate depression and anxiety. People who want help contact the service directly themselves. The NHS is looking at how these services are organised and are keen to understand people's experiences. Healthwatch wants to hear from people who have used the service or are waiting for therapy, what went well, what didn't go so well and any suggestions for improvements.

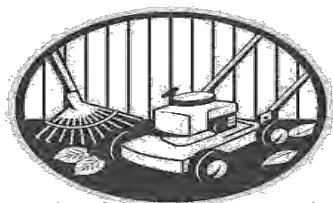

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News from Christ Church C.E. Primary School

Preparing, Sowing, Growing

Do you remember going to Arthog?



Have you been to Arthog as a child? Many adults who grew up in Shropshire have very happy memories of school residentials in the beautiful countryside and beaches around this stunning area of Wales near to Snowdonia and Barmouth.

I am glad to say that residentials are happening again in schools (post Covid) and we recently took nearly 40 children away. They had a wonderful time exploring rock pools, climbing, gorge walking and canoeing. We have another residential happening in a few weeks as well, this time at the Pioneer Centre near Cleobury Mortimer.

Outdoor education and residentials are brilliant for personal development. They gently push children out of their comfort zones and allow them to develop independence, resilience and confidence as they try new activities, stay overnight away from home and learn from different adults. We love them and are very glad to have a regular programme of residential visits to develop these skills.

We also use Arthog Outreach to support the provision of outdoor education in school and they have led some brilliant activities this year – from re-enacting Shackleton's Journey using the field as an ice sheet, to bringing in their portable climbing tower so our younger children could all try climbing. It also helps us get to know our local area – we have explored the Wrekin, done a local walk amongst farmland in Sheinton and will look forward to canoeing along our stretch of the River Severn in the summer.

It has recently been Children's Mental Health Week nationally and in school we have focused on being outdoors and being active as positive factors in mental health. Good for the adults too!
